Oxfordshire County Council plans to site a huge gravel pit on land between Cholsey and Wallingford to extract 5 million tonnes of sand and gravel. C.A.G.E has been set up to fight these plans. The plans will severely damage our local countryside and affect the lives of the 10,000 people who live in these two communities. The area will be blighted for over 25 years. The land between Cholsey and Wallingford is a peaceful and largely undisturbed area. The mining of 5 million tonnes of sand and gravel over 25 years on sites along the Wallingford Road and Reading Road will obliterate the current rural landscape. The mining will generate incessant noise from diggers, sifting machinery and create over 250 movements of gravel daily by 20 tonne lorries on local roads. Lorries will enter and exit the mining site on the Wallingford Road and will inevitably leave debris of dust, dirt and mud on local roads, especially the Wallingford Road. Danger and road congestion will abound. The whole communities of Cholsey/Wallingford and surrounding areas will be adversely affected if this plan goes ahead. [Help us to stop it now!](#)
